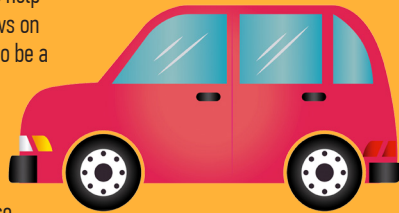

WILLS AND TRUSTS SEMINAR

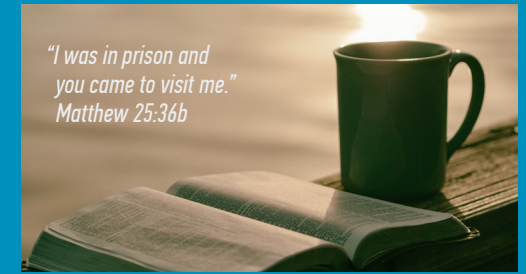
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 9AM TO NOON
