

Kids' Missions Program

Kids' Trip to Chile: Every year we take a short-term mission trip with 11-13 year olds who have displayed a heart for missions. These kids have completed the Kids' Missions Class and successfully served on the Kids' Wenatchee trip. This life changing opportunity begins with a 12 weekly training session (Sept-Nov) to help with team-building, learning Spanish, preparing drama, puppets, music, learning special skills, and working together. Team members raise their own support, have parental permission and must be able to miss 6 days of school. Our missionaries in Chile will host this team of 6 adults and 18 children. This is an incredible cross-culture experience allowing children to observe "missions at work" and grow spiritually as they serve others. (Nov 24– December 4)

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Kids in World Missions

World Missions is a passionate obedience to the Great Commission focused on reaching every tribe and every nation with the love of God through Jesus Christ. How can we develop Christians with that same passion and life-long commitment to the Great Commission? We believe the vision and passion for missions is best taught and developed in young children.



As children go through our Kids' Missions program, their worldview will be shaped by what they learn and experience in the classroom as well as hands-on opportunities to serve. Hopefully, every child will grow in their concern and love for missions at home and internationally.



Our desire is to grow a generation of young believers with a God centered worldview, who are active in sharing their faith through evangelism, service, and missions.



Kids' Missions Offering Project: Every two months an offering project is selected to help us educate kids on global needs, beliefs and evangelism strategies. By praying and giving, children can come alongside brothers and sisters in Christ throughout the world in a practical and prayerful way.

SonLife: Wednesday nights we provide a program for 4th-5th graders to help them grow in their relationship with God and with one another. They learn practical outreach skills like puppets, games, Sign Language, Spanish, and greeting.

Kids' Missions Class: Every Spring 4th and 5th graders can attend a 6 week class that covers a wide range of missions awareness topics to help prepare them for their next steps in practical missions.

Kids' Wenatchee Trip: Once they complete the Kids' Missions Class, kids can participate in a 4 day, hands-on mission trip to Eastern Washington, serving in local churches and organizations. We focus on service projects, observing firsthand missions, and putting to work what God has begun in them. (June 25-28)
