Agree with One Another

1 Corinthians 1:10 "I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought."



After watching the video...

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1. Why is it easier to notice the things that are different about each other instead of the things we agree on?
- 2. How do disagreements affect us as members of the same family?
- 3. When we're talking together, how can we try to focus on the things we agree on instead of the things we don't agree on?
- 4. What would be the biggest change in our family if we focused on agreeing with one another most of the time?

Let's pray.

- Thank God for giving us His Holy Spirit that binds us together as one family.
- Ask Him to teach us to look for the things we can agree on.
- Ask God to forgive us for being focused on differences and looking for things to argue about.
- Ask Him to help us become a family that fits together well, even with our differences.

Suggestions: Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own without showing the video to the family.
