Family Discussion Questions:

1. Tell about a time when someone tried to help you improve by telling you something you were doing was not exactly right.
2. When someone corrects us, we sometimes get angry and we don't want to hear it. Why do you think we do that?
3. Why do you think the Bible says that a wise person loves correction and a foolish person hates correction? (Proverbs 12)
4. If someone in your family wants to help you correct something, what's the best way for them to talk to you about it?

Let's Pray Together

- Thank God for His correction and helping us to grow up in Christ.
- Ask Him to forgive us for the times we were being foolish and didn't want to hear correction.
- Ask God to help us be open to the encouragement and help from others in our family.
- Ask Him to help us become a family that wants the very best for each other, encouraging one another every day without giving up!

Suggestions: Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own without showing the video to the family.
