## Family Discussion Questions:

1. If you were going to give a speech to honor someone in your family, would that be easy or difficult for you? Why?
2. Describe how it might feel to have people saying really good things about you, honoring you in front of others.
3. What are some ways that we can honor each other without making a big speech?
4. What do you think about the idea of honoring a different person in our family each night this week at dinner? (You could eat their favorite food and everyone say some good things about them.)

## Let's Pray Together

- Thank God for the way He shows great honor to us by sending Jesus to rescue us.
- Ask Him to help us show honor to one another in the way we speak to each other this week.
- Ask God to remind us when we start to make fun or uncover one another, to put away the arrows.
- Ask Him to help us be a family that honors one another in the things we say and do.

**Suggestions:** Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own without showing the video to the family.
