After watching the video...

Family Discussion Questions:

1. Let's look at each of the members of our family and name at least one thing that each person is really good at. What are those things?
2. How can we respect and show value for those things we just mentioned?
3. When we start to compete or try to be better than someone else, what can we do to remind each other to live in harmony?
4. Describe what our home would be like if everyone decided to live in harmony with one another all the time?

Let's pray together:

- Thank God for each member of your family and for the way God has gifted them.
- Ask Him to help you show value and respect for them.
- Ask Him to forgive you for the times you tried to be better than others and put them down.
- Ask God to help all of you live in harmony with each other.

Suggestions: Gather your family and ensure that everyone is seated comfortably. Hopefully, each member of the family can be seen and heard easily by everyone. Pray together, read the verse for today and then watch the video together. Pause the video after each of the discussion questions and encourage each family member to share. Afterwards, pray together following the suggested prayer points. Hopefully the discussion will continue throughout the day in a natural way. Another idea is to have one parent view the video in advance and then teach the lesson on their own, without showing the video to the family.
