Isaiah 6:1-8 January 2, 2022

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. The Bible is full of examples of people who lived a good life but messed up by turning temporarily stupid; please share an example that stands out to you.
- 2. Why did this example stand out to you and what did you take away from it?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message. Please read Isaiah 6:1-8

- 3. According to Pastor Steve what are the seven attributes of God revealed in these scriptures?
- 4. According to Pastor Steve, God is alive; what three ways can we see God?
- 5. Isaiah said, "I saw the Lord seated on a throne" (verse 1). According to Pastor Steve, what does the throne represent?
- 6. According to Pastor Steve, God is transcendent. Why did he choose this word to describe God?
- 7. How does God's gloriousness complete His holiness?
- 8. Please read Isaiah 6:5-7, Matthew 12:34, Hebrews 4:13, Isaiah 64:6 and John 3:16. Just like Isaiah we are all in need of being rescued. Compare and contrast Isaiah's redemption experience to ours.

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

9. Isaiah goes from – "I am dead" to "Here am I. Send me" and from "Shut my mouth" to "Use me." Write a prayer asking God's direction in how you can better serve Him.
