START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. What is the difference between friendship and fellowship?
- 2. What does it mean to be unequally yoked with unbelievers and what are the obvious dangers of doing so?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

Read 2 Corinthians 6:14-16

- 3. Read Matthew 5:13-16 and 2 Corinthians 5:19-20. What do these verses teach us about cultivating our friendships with unbelievers?
- 4. Read John 1:14. Pastor Steve said, "We have the power of grace and truth." Describe how both grace and truth help us in our relationships with unbelievers.
- 5. Read Luke 19:9-10. Pastor Steve stated, "Compassion is friendship's best friend." According to Pastor Steve, how does compassion have a way of allowing people to see Jesus?
- 6. Read John 8:10-11 and Romans 8:1. What can we learn from these verses about sharing the good news of Jesus' forgiveness with our unbelieving friends?
- 7. Read 2 Corinthians 4:4. Who is the god of this world and in what ways did Pastor Steve say he blinds the minds of unbelievers?

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 8. How has this sermon helped you hear God's call for you to intentionally and compassionately reach out to become friends with unbelievers?
- 9. Are there any unbelievers in your life that you may have given up on or may be ignoring? If so, how will you commit to reach out to them?
