## **Don't Fear The Headlines**

2 Thessalonians 2:13-17, April 10, 2022, Pastor Dustin Slezak

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. Share a time you received news where the outcome was totally different than the "what ifs" playing out in your mind.
- 2. What typically has been your first response when you receive unexpected bad news?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

Please read 2 Thessalonians 2: 13-17

- 3. According to Paul, in all circumstances we are to be thankful. Please read 2 Thessalonians 2:13, Ephesians 1:4 and 1 Corinthians 6:19. What two examples for being thankful did Paul provide? How do they affect your faith?
- 4. Paul goes on to say that in all circumstances we are to stand on the truth. How does standing on the truth allow us to confront our circumstances in life?
- 5. Pastor Slezak provided three practical steps to help you stand firm when you receive bad news. What are these three steps and what are their importance?
- 6. Paul reminds us not to be fearful because we are loved. Please read 1 John 4:10. Why is knowing and believing this truth so powerful?

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.
