2 Corinthians 12:7-10 June 11, 2023

START TALKING | asking questions to get you thinking.

- 1. How many people in the world have little or no access to the Bible, other Christians or the Gospel?
- 2. Why do you think that many churches in the U.S. are no longer sending missionaries?

START SHARING | asking questions that engage with the message.

Read 2 Corinthians 12:7-10.

- 3. God's grace did more for Paul than save him. Describe how Paul was able to continue in ministry. See 2 Corinthians 11:23-29.
- 4. Pastor Steve said that grace moves the last in line to the front of the line. How did this happen for:
 - a. The Samaritan woman (John 4:7-29)
 - b. Peter (Matt 26:33-35, Acts 4:13).
 - c. Mary Magdalene (Luke 8:2, John 20:11-18)
 - d. Mary (Luke 1:26-38)
- 5. How does marginalizing ourselves and the world prevent missionary activity?
- 6. How did the grace given to Paul enable him to face the unknown (Acts 20:22-24).

START LIVING | asking questions that apply God's Word to daily life.

- 8. How are you going to respond to Pastor Steve's challenge to be a grace-filled ambassador?
