START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

- 1. Think about how you would describe a beach, a mountain, or a city to a blind person. Share the insights you gained attempting to convey the unseen just as John grappled with describing the throne room in Revelation.
- 2. Imagine standing at the threshold of eternity and experiencing the throne of Jesus. What emotions and thoughts would fill your heart and mind?

START SHARING | Get your group engaging with the message.

Read Revelation 4:1-11

- 3. How did Pastor Steve relate the jewels in Revelation 4:3a to God's love? What impact of God's love did he ascribe to John 3:16-17 and Ephesians 2:4-5 regarding our understanding of salvation and grace?
- 4. How does Jesus' promise in John 14:1-3 intersect with the rainbow in Revelation 4:3b as a symbol of God's covenant and faithfulness, as mentioned in Genesis 9:8-17?
- 5. Please read Revelation 4:4-6, 10 and Psalm 2:1-5. What do these symbols and God's response to the nation's anger and futile plans reveal about His power and sovereignty?
- 6. What insights can we glean from the role of the living creatures and elders described in Revelation 4:7-11, and what does their continuous worship suggest about the authority and holiness of God?

START LIVING | Get your group applying God's Word to daily life.

- 7. In what ways do you currently need a heavenly perspective to keep your eyes fixed on Jesus?
- 8. How can the reality of eternity actively guide your life and the decisions you make?
