BIG IDEA: God has given us all we need to turn the opposition of the enemy into opportunities to give God glory!

1. Ephesians 6:10 - Dependence on God

TAKE AWAY

The strength of a Christian life is a total dependence on God.

- 3. Will you ask God today to help you learn to depend on Him more?
- 4. What attributes of God could you focus on when you are tempted to depend on self in a crisis?

- What is the overall definition of the Armor of God?
- · What are the devil's schemes?
- Who is the battle against?

TAKE AWAY

Our battle is not against people, it's against the devil!



FOLLOW UP: Time alone with God

Read Ephesians 6:10-18.

- 1. What conflict or situation in your life is difficult? Is there a person in your life that is hard to get along with?
- 2. Will you ask God to help you see that person with His eyes?
- 3. Will you commit to praying for that person?
- 4. Will you ask God to help you see the battle is spiritual and not that person?
