  - c. How does God's final judgment give meaning and worth to living the Christian life?
- 5. Jesus is worthy of being Lord.
  - a. How does the triumph of Jesus, the Lion of Judah, connect with the promise of Romans 10:11?
  - b. How does Matthew 6:10 enhance our understanding of the Lamb's role in Revelation 5:7-8?
  - c. What is the lifestyle of most of humanity due to their rejection of God's truth?
- 6. What is the irreversible judgment that God will make upon the earth?
