START TALKING | *Get your group thinking.*

1. Share your thoughts on the concept of irreversible consequences from events throughout history.
2. Give an example of a decision you or someone you know has made, and how it influenced your life and/or your faith.

START SHARING | *Get your group engaging with the message.*

Read Revelation 5

3. In Revelation 5:4, why is John in despair?
4. God's final judgment upon humanity is irreversibly ready.
 - a. How does the messianic language of Revelation 5:5 relate to the prophecies found in Genesis 49:8-10 and Isaiah 11?
 - b. What insights can we draw from the symbolism of the Lion and the Lamb in Revelation 5:5-7, considering Genesis 49:8-10 and John 1:29?
 - c. How does God's final judgment give meaning and worth to living the Christian life?
5. Jesus is worthy of being Lord.
 - a. How does the triumph of Jesus, the Lion of Judah, connect with the promise of Romans 10:11?
 - b. How does Matthew 6:10 enhance our understanding of the Lamb's role in Revelation 5:7-8?
 - c. What is the lifestyle of most of humanity due to their rejection of God's truth?
6. What is the irreversible judgment that God will make upon the earth?
