1. Stand firm with the Belt of Truth (vs.14)

2. Stand firm with the Breastplate of Righteousness (vs.14b)

TAKE AWAY

The breastplate of righteousness means to live a life of obedience to the Word of God because we love Jesus. We are confident in our salvation and our righteous standing before God because of Jesus.

3. Feet fitted with the readiness from the Gospel of Peace (vs. 15)

TAKE AWAY

The feet fitted with the gospel of peace means we stand firm because the Prince of Peace secures us against the enemy. We don't live in fear, but we are secure in our faith!
